## **2024-25 ACADEMIC COURSES**

## **ACC 111: PRINCIPLES OF ACCOUNTING I**

In this introductory course, students learn accounting principles and theory with emphasis on the accounting cycle, recording and valuation of assets,  $\frac{1}{2}$ liabilities and stockholders' equity, financial reporting and an introduction to accounting systems and controls. Students will also perform financial analysis, which will include assessing a company's ability to pay off its liabilities. The title of this course was previously Principles of Accounting I.

Level I Prereq: Academic Reading and Writing Levels of 6; Academic Math Level 3 or MTH 125 or MTH 160, minimum grade "C"; MTH 125 or MTH 160, may enroll concurrently
