In the lab, students will develop an understanding on how to service, diagnose and replace faulty internal transmission and drivetrain components. Topics will also include drivetrain function and differences in both 2 and 4-wheel drive vehicles as well as identification, diagnosis and repair of major driveline components that affect transmission operation.
