## 2024-25 ACADEMIC COURSES

### **CJT 170 : DOMESTIC & INTERNAT. TERRORISM**

---

In this course, students will study domestic terrorism and international terrorism, with a focus on how the federal and state governments respond to and investigate terrorism. Students will explore the roots of terrorism, types, causes, strategies, targets and weapons. The course will include an overview of how other crimes are used by terrorists for funding and the impact of media coverage. Students will engage in practical exercises such as a mock response to possible threats of terrorism, and they will become aware of how counterterrorism agencies and task forces analyze initial threat information and formulate responses to threats of terrorism.
