NUR 128 : NURSING CONCEPTS II

In this course, students will apply the nursing process to provide safe, quality nursing care for patients with common acute and chronic health problems across the lifespan, including care of the family during the childbearing experience. This course also includes clinical, lab and simulation in a variety of settings where students will apply informatics and technology for effective communication.

Level I Prereq: Academic Reading and Writing Levels of 6; BIO 147 or BIO 237 and BIO 212, minimum grade "C"; NUR 108 and NUR 115, minimum grade "C+"; and PSY 206 minimum grade "C"; PSY 206 may enroll concurrently
