### **RAD 222 : PHARMACOLGY DIAGNOSTIC IMAGING**

In this course, students are introduced to pharmacology and contrast media administration as it relates to the medical imaging profession. Students will gain an understanding of diagnostic contrast media and the effects of these agents on the human body. They will also receive instruction in basic techniques of venipuncture, appropriate patient care practices during drug administration and management of medical emergencies in the diagnostic imaging department.
