In this course, students will work under the supervision of the team leaders and department managers in a clinical setting. Students will demonstrate professional behaviors and effective communication skills. Students will actively participate in the process of decontamination, set assembly, sterilization, sterile storage, and distribution of sterile instrumentation and supplies. Students will be exposed to bloodborne pathogens during their clinical experience.
