TAX 101 : INCOME TAXES FOR INDIVIDUALS

In this course, students will receive practical experience in preparation of an income tax return, both manually and using tax return computer software. The course is designed for those seeking employment as paraprofessionals in the tax field. Individuals who simply wish to understand their own taxes can benefit as well. Students must be able to work with numbers and computer applications. This is a beginning course in Individual Tax Return preparation covering both Federal and Michigan taxes that affect individuals. Level I prerequisite: Academic Reading and Writing Levels of 6; Academic Math Level 3 or MTH 125, MTH 125X, MTH 160, or MTH 160X, or ACC 111; minimum grade "C" in all courses; may enroll concurrently in ACC or MTH
