In this course students will write, produce, direct and edit at least two non-fictional videos. Students will be instructed on methods and hands-on skills to construct a non-fictional story. This includes formulating a story with an angle, structure, content and style. Interviewing and researching methods are demonstrated through hands-on exercises. Students view/critique various contemporary documentaries as they relate them to their own projects. The title of this course was previously Documentary and Reality Videos. Level I
